The Cathedral Centennial Concert *in The Cathedral* *The Dream of Gerontius, op. 38* by Sir Edward Elgar

Composed roughly during the time The Cathedral of the Madeleine was being built, Sir Edward Elgar's *The Dream of Gerontius* is a dramatic setting of the 1865 poem written by recently beatified John Cardinal Henry Newman. Cardinal Newman's poem reflects on the transition from life to life eternal, but expresses the thoughts and emotions not of a saint, priest or religious luminary, but rather those of an ordinary person. The music, which the composer identified as "...the best of me..." received its premiere in 1900 and features three soloists, two choirs, and a large orchestra. Tenor Martin Thompson will perform the role of Gerontius/Soul, Mezzo Soprano Kirsten Gunlogson will sing the part of the Guardian Angel, and Baritone Tyler Oliphant will perform as the Priest and the Angel present at Christ's Agony. The Cathedral Choir and Orchestra are under the direction of Cathedral Music Director Gregory Glenn.

Solemn Vespers with Children's Procession in *The Cathedral*

Vespers for the Solemnity of the Assumption begins the official celebration of the Centennial Anniversary of The Cathedral. The Most Reverend George H. Niederaurer, Archbishop of San Francisco, will be the Homilist for this service celebrated in the presence of His Eminence William Joseph Cardinal Levada, Prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith and other visiting Bishops. The service will be preceded by a procession of children, beginning from the location of the original cathedral built in 1871, and processing to the new cathedral on South Temple Street.
