

LOITERING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY/NON-AUTHORIZED PERSONS

Proper control is to be exercised by the school administration and faculty to insure the safety and welfare of students, personnel, and staff. Control shall also be exercised to protect the physical areas of buildings and grounds. The school administration shall be responsible to handle any situation that may arise because of a trespasser or any acts there from. The following procedures and guidelines will be used in administering this policy.

1. The principal is to have an understandable knowledge of the local, city, and/or county ordinances or state codes.
2. The principal shall inform his/her staff and students of said ordinances and codes.
3. The principal shall post in a conspicuous place in his/her building, rules and regulations pertaining to all visitors.
4. The principal shall have the right to utilize every effort in the protection of students, personnel, and property.
5. Whenever a principal deems a person to be endangering persons or property, he/she shall ask the party to leave the school property.
6. If the person fails to heed the warning to vacate the school property, the principal shall immediately secure assistance from an appropriate law enforcement agency.
7. Students should be instructed regarding the dangers of accepting materials, invitations, or associating in any way with strangers on or near school grounds. Students should report such activities to the principal.
