EMPLOYEE HEALTH CARE

It is expected that employees take reasonable steps to maintain good health.

Employee Tuberculin Test

In accordance with the regulations adopted by the State Board of Health in 1994, tuberculin testing of all newly employed adult school personnel is required within two weeks of hire unless the employee is known to have had a previous positive tuberculin test. The employee known to have a previous positive TB test must obtain a chest x-ray or provide proof that a chest x-ray has been done within the last year.

If the tuberculin test is negative, no further testing is necessary. It is the responsibility of the principal to see that the tuberculin test is done and properly documented.
