Jan. 14: A Catholic Response to the Death Penalty

and religiously. Pope Francis recently defined the death penalty as “completely inadmissible.” More than two thirds of the world’s 200 countries have abolished the death penalty. Our lecture and discussion will explain, clarify and examine this important issue.
