THE ANGELUS

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary,

R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you, Blessed are you among women And blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God Pray for us sinners, Now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

R. Be it done unto me according to Your Word. Hail Mary.....

And the Word was made flesh

R. And dwelt among us. Hail Mary.....

Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray:

Pour forth, we beseech You, O Lord, Your Grace into our hearts; that as we have known the incarnation of Christ, your Son, by the message of an angel, so by His passion and cross, we may be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.

O Mary, Refuge of sinners and Health of the sick, you gave hope to your people in time of distress, and brought them comfort in time of sorrow.

Keep us under your mantle of protection, especially those who are suffering from the coronavirus disease, and those who care for the sick and minister to their needs, as your Son implores us to do for one another.

Be with us now as a sign of salvation and hope, as we entrust ourselves to your loving care. Help us, O Mother of Divine Love in times of tribulation, to remain steadfast in faith in the midst of fear, suffering and death. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
