




# COLORING BOOK

*Luke 2: 1-7*




Saint Joseph loved Mary and Jesus.


*Matthew 2: 13-15*

The desert land probably had many challenges, but Joseph was always there to help out.






Saint Joseph loved Jesus and Mary. He took good care of the family when they reached Egypt.

Joseph worked as a carpenter when they arrived back in Judea. He taught Jesus many things: how to be a worker, how to pray and to read God's word.



When Jesus was twelve years old, he and his family went on a special trip called a pilgrimage where they joined many others in special prayers. On the way back home, Mary and Joseph became separated from Jesus. They were worried and looked everywhere for him. They found him teaching grown men about the Lord. Jesus told Joseph and Mary that he had been in his Father's house. Joseph again trusted that the Lord was guiding his family.
