
DISTINCTIONS

- You have no control over reconciliation.
- Forgiveness does not remove the responsibility for justice
- Forgiveness does not condone the actions of the other

SIX STEPS IN DEALING WITH LOSS AND TERMINATION

1 Get in touch with all the emotions you are experiencing.

2 Accept all the feelings.

3 Talk about the feelings.

4 Allow sufficient time to grieve.

5 Ritualize the loss

6 Allow new people to enter your life.
