

REQUEST FOR SCHOOL CLOSING

Any consideration of permanently closing or substantially changing the enrollment of a Catholic school in the Diocese of Salt Lake City must be initiated in writing by the principal of a school with the superintendent of Catholic Schools. The Catholic Schools Office, at the direction of the Superintendent, will direct a thorough study of the situation and alternatives. The Superintendent will present recommendations to the bishop. The actual decision to close a school can be made only by the bishop.

Sufficient time should be provided in announcing a closure to allow faculty to seek employment and for student enrollment opportunities at other Catholic schools where available.
