Lay Teacher Salary Schedules

A diocesan salary schedule has been established and approved by the bishop for all the schools of the diocese. It is designed to provide equitable compensation for lay teachers. No one may deviate from the published salary schedule.

The salary schedule is published and made available to all employees and applicants in the school system

Substitute Teacher Salary

Whenever a regular teacher is absent, the principal is required to make every reasonable effort to obtain a qualified substitute teacher.

The administration of the school is to determine the wages of a substitute teacher. Local public school salary practices should be taken into consideration as well as the teaching of the Church regarding just wages.

Long-term substitutes should be paid more per day because of the responsibilities of planning, grading, etc.
