

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

The principal is required to provide the opportunity for the teacher and each student's parent(s)/guardian(s) to meet at least twice a year for the purpose of constructively discussing the student's rate of progress in school and other matters of mutual concern. Such conferences will be scheduled by the principal at a time set for parent-teacher conferences.

Teachers are encouraged to schedule additional conferences with the parent(s)/guardian(s) at other times and as often as needed to insure good channels of communication.

Three days are allowed for parent-teacher conferences. Adequate evening time must be provided for working parent(s)/guardian(s). Each individual school will determine the evening schedule for conferences. If the full three days are not required because of enrollment and/or scheduled conferences, the school shall hold classes for the remaining time.
